

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Registration and formation of groups

- Registration is done in writing using the appropriate application form.
- Tennis lessons are given in groups of 3 or 4 participants.
- **A minimum of three participants of the same level is needed to form a group.**
- The assessment of the level of the players for the formation of the groups is the sole responsibility of the Tennis Professional.
- Groups are formed upon receipt of all registrations.

Paielement

- The participant or, if applicable, his representative, agrees to pay the invoice for the module within 30 days from the date of invoice.
- Billing will be done by e-mail. However, a payment slip can be requested from the course supervisor.

Absences

- All absences must be announced to the course supervisor.
- Only courses missed more than 4 times due to injury or illness may be made up in another group. A medical certificate is then required.
- Missed classes can only be made up during the current season.
- Except in cases of extenuating circumstances, no financial compensation or reimbursement of the subscription may be requested if the registrant stops attending classes before the term defined at registration.

- Each participant must behave properly and respect teachers' instructions. The Course Supervisor reserves the right to exclude a participant whose behavior would be detrimental to the proper functioning of the courses. In these circumstances no financial contribution or reimbursement of the contribution may be requested.
